## INTRODUCTION

**S**eismic global shifts of our time alter the nature of the threat to Western civilization – yet they also open unprecedented opportunities for peace.

As this book shows, a new path to peace emerged which has nothing to do with legacy peace frameworks and assumptions – those only stand in the way.

While the focus in 2026 has naturally been on Iran, we are also at a pivotal point in Europe’s dramatic fall from grace.

Europe, which dominated the world for 2,000 years, has not come to terms with last century’s swift shift of power to America, and is actively challenging US global leadership. It created a new power-base, legal might, to counter America’s military and economic might, and identified a vector to attack America (“big war criminal”), through Israel (“little war criminal”).

My column in *The Jerusalem Post* has been analyzing those historical changes, while applying the frameworks from my previous book, *The Assault on Judaism*, to make policy recommendations.

This new book amalgamates those column articles into a cohesive narrative. It shows the interlinkage between the various geopolitical developments and how they lead to a new vision for peace:

**Part I** places our era’s monumental changes in their historic context. It shows that those shifts require us to dump old frameworks, such as the “two-state solution”,

as well as move away from the human tendency to go back to the way things were.

**Parts II and III** delve into the growing Europe vs. America divide, and how it is shaping the contemporary assault on Judaism.

While the first three parts of this book show how the assault on Judaism matured in 2025 into an imminent threat to global stability, the last two parts suggest strategies to counter the assault (Part IV), and turn it around towards peace (Part V).

**Part IV** outlines immediate actions President Trump can take, including ways to neutralize the growing threat of lawfare and remove artificial hurdles to peace placed by Europe.

**Part V** offers a revolutionary approach to peace that is based on organic Middle Eastern realities, not Western-imposed thinking – paradoxically, realities that were generated through the assault on Judaism described in the first three sections.

Indeed, a unique set of circumstances emerged in 2026 that could lead to sustainable peace in the Middle East and beyond.

This book is based on articles that were written to generate impact. I would like to thank all those who funneled those articles to the right places.

Over the last two years, we have witnessed miracle after miracle, as the Jewish nation was fending off a simultaneous physical assault coming from Iran and its proxies, and an ideological assault coming from Europe and its proxies. I am constantly and eternally grateful to God for all the miracles that enable our cherished life here at home. I hope this new book can help us chart a path from survival towards peace, and pray that in doing so, God will bless our leaders, fighters, thinkers, learners and doers with good advice and great success.
